



Call for Applications for a Tenure-Track Faculty Position (All Ranks*)
The Bob Shapell School of Social Work, Tel Aviv University
For the 2026–2027 Academic Year

The position is a full-time (100%) tenure-track appointment open to all academic ranks. The appointment is expected to begin on October 1, 2026.

Eligibility Requirements:

1. **A Ph.D. and a B.A. (BSW) and/or M.A. (MSW) in Social Work.**
2. **Or:**
A **Ph.D.** in a closely related discipline, with a strong connection to the field of Social Work—addressing theoretical, research, or applied aspects relevant to social work practice, welfare services, target populations, or social problems with which the profession engages.
3. **Postdoctoral training** of at least one year abroad (required for candidates whose Ph.D. was earned in Israel).

Required Qualifications

1. Demonstrated ability to conduct high-quality research and to publish in leading peer-reviewed journals (top quartiles) or other recognized platforms of research excellence in the candidate's field.
2. Ability to supervise graduate (Masters and Ph.D.) students.
3. Teaching experience and readiness to teach in both **Hebrew and English**, in small and large classes, in the BSW., MSW., and Ph.D. programs.
4. Commitment to scientific and social leadership, including the ability to influence the design and direction of welfare services and public policy in relevant domains.
5. Ability to recruit competitive research funding from national and international grant agencies.

Candidates will be evaluated based on these criteria and the relevance of their area of specialization (research/teaching) to the academic and professional needs of the School. Appointment procedures will follow the academic appointment regulations of the Tel Aviv University and will be subject to approval by the University's academic authorities. The academic rank will be determined according to the candidate's qualifications.

Application Materials

Applicants should submit the following:

- Curriculum vitae in the format required by the Tel Aviv University Academic Secretariat.
- List of scientific publications.
- Academic biography including a **future research plan** (2–3 pages).
- List of research and teaching interests.



- Up to five publications (articles published or accepted for publication) or books (published or accepted for publication), as appropriate to the norms of the candidate's field.
- Candidates **without a B.S.W or M.S.W.** must attach a detailed explanation describing the relationship between their research and professional interests and the field of Social Work and welfare services, and how their work may contribute to the development of relevant knowledge in these areas.
- Names and contact details (address, phone number, and e-mail) of **three referees** who have agreed to provide letters of recommendation.
- Teaching evaluations (if available).
